Application is disposed of.

Main case

The petitioner retired as a Peon from Nagar Council, Bagha Purana, District Moga, on 31.12.2014. It is stated that the remaining retiral benefits, as mentioned in the present writ petition, have not been released so far. The petitioner made representations dated 13.12.2016 and 29.12.2016 (Annexures-P-1 and P-2 respectively) to respondents and also served a legal notice dated 4.2.2017 (Annexure-P-3) upon respondents, but the remaining retiral benefits have not been released so far. No chargesheet or inquiry is stated to be pending against the petitioner.

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In these circumstances, without issuing notice to opposite party, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3 to consider the legal notice dated 4.2.2017 (Annexure-P-3) and if there is no legal impediment in release of the remaining retiral benefits, the same be released forthwith, otherwise a speaking order be passed denying the said benefits, within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
