ARUN PALLI, J. (ORAL):

Learned counsel for the parties submit that the present appeal arises out of an injunction application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure. And, vide impugned order dated 28.01.2015, the injunction prayed for, by the plaintiff, had since been declined. It is submitted that a considerable time has elapsed, and even the suit is at the stage of final arguments. Thus, without examining the matter on merits, let the appeal be disposed of, and the appellant, may pursue his cause before the trial Court, itself.

That being so, the appeal is disposed of, in the above terms. It is clarified that notwithstanding the order dated 28.01.2015, the trial Court shall decide the matter in accordance with law.
