Suraj Kali Vs M/s Vikram Bus Service and another

As agreed, as per statements of the representative of the Insurance Company and counsel for the appellant, (separately recorded today), a sum of ₹ 1,90,000/- (₹ One Lakh Ninty Thousand Only) more, over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded as enhanced compensation to the appellant, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant the enhanced amount would be paid to the appellant-Suraj Kali.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of ₹ 1,90,000/- in the name of appellant-Suraj Kali wife of Ram Kishan with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 22.12.2017 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellant's counsel/appellant my collect the cheque from the office.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
