By this writ petition, the petitioners have challenged the action of the respondents in not granting four more marks to them as per the decision of this Court, Annexure P-12.

Counsel for the petitioners states that in this connection, the petitioners have moved a representation (Annexure P-14) and that they would be satisfied at this stage if in the first instance a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the same by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time since the validity of this exam is only till 2018.

I find this to be a fair request. Resultantly, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation of the petitioners by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a

certified copy of this order.

This petition stand disposed of in the above terms.
