This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the notice under Section 13(2) of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (in short 'the SARFAESI Act') issued by respondent No.2.
