The instant writ petition has been filed seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to treat the petitioners as having been relieved on 27th September, 2016 and for release of retiral benefits thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that a legal notice dated 26.12.2016 (Annexure P-5) has already been served in this regard, which is pending consideration and prays that the same should be decided as expeditiously as possible.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and in view of the limited prayer, I dispose of the writ petition by directing respondents to decide the legal notice of the petitioners dated 26.12.2016 (Annexure P-5)

preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
