Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the Pension, Commutation of pension, Arrears of pension, amount of GIS along with interest @ 12% per annum and also grant interest @ 12% per annum on delayed payment of Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity (DCRG), Leave Encashment, GPF to the petitioner.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that relief which has been claimed through the instant petition has already been given to the petitioner by the respondents and instant petition has rendered infructuous.

3. Dismissed as having become infructuous.
