Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after statements having been made by Sarpanch and Gram Sachiv that full information had been provided and that in case the petitioner needed any further clarification, she was ready to clear the doubts, it was decided between the parties that respondent Sarpanch shall meet the complainant within a week's time at block headquarters wherein each and every shortcomings in information as pointed out by the petitioner would be taken care of.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on said assurance, the case was disposed of by the State Information Commissioner but the information mentioned in para 4 of the original application pertaining to year from August, 2010 to June, 2016, has not been supplied.

I have considered the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner and I am of the opinion that the petitioner has approached this Court for strict implementation and adherence to the order dated 22.12.2016. This Court cannot assume the role of an Executing Court for the State Information Commissioner. In case, the petitioner has got any

grievance of non-compliance of order dated 22.12.2016, it can always approach the State Information Commissioner for providing the copies of the work orders, for the information sought for in para 4 in Annexure P-1 (original application). In case, any such application is filed within a period of 15 days, the State Information Commissioner will be entitled to revive the petition and seek implementation of the undertaking given by the concerned Sarpanch and Gram Sachiv.

Disposed of with above observations.
