After arguing for some time learned counsel for the petitioner states that he would not press this petition at this stage but liberty may be granted to his client to make a representation to respondent No.2 and respondent No.2 is directed to decide the same by passing a speaking order thereon.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, the petition is dismissed as not pressed at this stage. In case the petitioner moves any representation within a period of one month from today the respondent No.2 shall decide the said representation by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of three months thereafter.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
