Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is imminent threat to the business and profession of the petitioner on account of the electricity and water supply having been curtailed making the petitioner unable to perform his contractual obligations.

In this context, the petitioner has sent a legal notice to the respondents.

Since the grievance of the petitioner is yet to be considered and adjudicated upon by the respondents, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to the Managing Director, Punjab Health System Corporation, Mohali and the Director of Institute of Medical Health, Govt. Mental Hospital, Amritsar to consider the claim of the petitioner in legal notice Annexure P-8 within a period of one month by passing a speaking order and to intimate the final decision to the petitioner in order to enable him to avail appropriate legal remedy available to him.

The claim of the petitioner for interim relief for immediately restoration of the amenities like electricity and water supply will also be

taken into consideration within a period of one week by the above said authorities after the receipt of certified copy of this order.

It will be the responsibility of the petitioner to communicate the order to the above said authorities.
