The grievance of the petitioner in the instant writ petition is that she has been allotted a plot measuring 6 marla by the HUDA in Sector 32 (Part)/33 (Part), Urban Estate, Karnal, in draw of lots held in May, 2014. It appears that on account of pending litigation, HUDA has not allotted specific plot numbers to the allottees. The said litigation has come to an end on 27.04.2016. It is alleged that despite almost a year has passed, no specific plot number has been allotted to the petitioner and other allottees.

The petitioner has in this regard represented the authorities followed by a legal notice dated 13.10.2016 sent through registered post but finding no response thereto, the instant writ petition has been filed.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the fact that now litigation is over and there appears to be no legal impediment against allotment of specific numbers of plots to the allottees and delay on the part of the authorities is totally uncalled for, we dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the Estate Officer, HUDA, Karnal, as well as the Administrator, HUDA, Panchkula, to consider the legal notice

served on behalf of the petitioner and take appropriate action in accordance with law, within a period of two months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
