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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The petitioner, who was working with respondent-department and retired as a driver from the Punjab Roadways, SBS Nagar Depot, has challenged the bill No. 49, dated 23.2.2011, vide which recovery of Rs. 1,82,994/- was made. He has also challenged the order dated 7.11.2008 (Annexure-P-1), vide which recovery of Rs. 1,06,201/- was ordered to be made.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner, I am of the view that the impugned orders were passed in the years 2008 and 2011. The present writ petition was filed in the month of January, 2017, and is badly barred by delay and laches. Hence, the present writ petition is dismissed.
