The instant petition has been filed with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to implement the transfer order dated 18.08.2016.

The petitioner herein, who is Lecturer in Geography, came to be transferred from Govt. Senior Secondary School, Rajeara, District Moga to Govt. Senior Secondary School, Saraina, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, however to date, has not been relieved nor permitted to join at the new place of posting. Aggrieved, the petitioner has filed his representation on 06.09.2016, which was subsequently followed by detailed representation dated 22.09.2016. Counsel for the petitioner argues that neither the representation of the petitioner has been decided nor his transfer order is being given effect too. The instant petition has been filed against the inaction of the respondents in not deciding his representation.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and in view of the above, I dispose of the writ petition by directing respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioner as expeditiously as possible. The petitioner is directed to file his fresh representation along with certified copy of this order within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Respondent No.2 herein is directed to dispose of the said representation preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the said representation along with certified copy of the order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
