Through instant petition, the petitioner seeks a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to make the payments of bill for construction of roads with interlocking tiles, development and augmentation of water supply etc. undertaken by the petitioner.

In this context, the petitioner has already sent a legal notice to the various authorities of Municipal Corporation, Gurgaon. Copy of the legal notice has been placed on record as Annexure P-1.

After considering the facts and circumstances of the case, I am of the opinion that it will be expedient, in the interest of justice, to dispose of this petition with a direction to the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Gurgaon to consider the claim of the petitioner as put forth in legal notice Annexure P-1 dated 24.01.2017 within a period of three months after the receipt of certified copy of this order. Ordered accordingly.

In case, the petitioner is found entitled to any payment, the same will be released expeditiously after above consideration.

It will be the duty of the petitioner to communicate the order to the above said authority.
