At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief claimed in this petition the petitioner has also moved a Legal Notice dated 10.02.2016 (Annexure P-5) and at this stage he would be satisfied if the same is decided by the respondent No.2 by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

However, it is made clear that in case the petitioner is found entitled for the

relief claimed the same be granted to him within the aforesaid period.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc.
Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
