At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that for the relief claimed in this petition the petitioners have also moved a Representation dated 11.11.2016 (Annexure P-5) and at this stage they would be satisfied if the same is decided by the respondent No.3 by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time keeping in mind the fact that the posts of SPOs against which the petitioners are seeking benefit are on contractual basis.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to decide the said representation by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

However, it is made clear that in case the petitioners are found entitled for the relief claimed the same be granted to them within the aforesaid period.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
