Petitioner has preferred the present writ petition for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.2 and 3, to pay a sum of Rs.10 lacs as compensation on account of fault of the Punjab School Education Board, having shown that he has not secured 836 marks out of 1000 in his senior secondary examination from the Board and had secured 695 marks on the basis of which information, he was ousted from the selection of Constable besides suffering other damages on account of wrong information.

I have considered the facts and circumstances of the present case.

The petitioner has already submitted a representation Annexure 16 dated 2.1.2017, intimating the respondents about the mistake committed by the Board authorities and the damages suffered by him. It will be expedient, in the interest of justice, in case a direction is issued, at this stage to the Secretary, Punjab School Education Board, Mohali, to consider the circumstances mentioned in the representation Annexure 16 dated 2.1.2017, and intimate the petitioner the decision taken on the same.

This petition is disposed of, at this stage, as pre-mature with a direction to the Secretary, Punjab School Education Board, Mohali, to consider the representation Annexure 16 dated 2.1.2017, and pass a speaking order and intimate the petitioner about the decision taken by the Board regarding the claim of the petitioner within a period of 3 months after the receipt of a certified copy of the order. This order will not prejudice the right of the petitioner to challenge the decision of the Board if he is still aggrieved.
