By this petition the petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for inter-district transfer as per the condition No.(iv) of paragraph No.3 of Policy 2015 (Annexure P-1) which is as under:-

“3(iv). Teachers suffering from terminal diseases i.e. Cancer/AIDS etc. or from chronic illness of serious nature, which requires special medical treatment and constant care of their family members. The medical certificate issued by Pandit Bhagwat Dayal Sharma PGIMS Rohtak (Government of Haryana) or Post Graduate Institute of Medical Science and Research (PGIMR), Chandigarh or AIIMS, Delhi for these diseases/illness shall only be considered. No other illness/disease shall be considered. The teachers whose children/spouse/parents is suffering from disease/illness shall

also be considered under this category.

The father of the petitioner who is over 60 years of age is suffering from chronic heart disease. Nothing has been shown as to what special care the patient requires. It is otherwise well known that heart disease may be chronic but is now widely prevalent and there are excellent management techniques for the same like Stents, Angioplasty, Bypass Surgery, Balloon, Cardioversion, EECPP etc. In the circumstances, there is no merit in this petition.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
