The compensation awarded by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Gurgaon for 2% disability resulting from the motor accident in a sum of ₹ 3, 35,700/- by an award dated 28.07.2015 with 7.5% interest from the date of the filing of the petition till payment together with counsel fee assessed at ₹ 5,500/- is in the considered view of this court and a reasonable recompense for the pain and suffering faced by the claimant as a result of the accident. The injury has left a permanent disability of just 2% which hardly impacts any future employment. The claimant was a young man of 18 years when the accident occurred and at far too young an age to be worried about his future with no visible signs of bodily disability left except the internal plates inserted by orthopedic doctors.

No ground is made for interference and appeal is dismissed.
