By this petition the petitioner has claimed that after having cleared the initial hurdles when he went for the scrutiny he was informed that his candidature has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if he be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to file a representation to the respondent No.1 and a direction be issued to the respondent No.1 to decide the said representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, the petition stands disposed of as having been withdrawn. In case the petitioner

moves a representation to the respondent No.1 within one week from today the same be decided within two weeks thereafter by passing a speaking order thereon.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
