It has inter alia been contended that respondent No.7, to whom the shop appears to have been allotted to run “Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendra” in Guru Nanak Dev Hospital, Amritsar, is not holding the requisite qualifications and eligibility criteria.

Since the shop has not yet been allotted to any one under “Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendra” in the vicinity of Guru Nanak Dev Hospital, Amritsar, the present petition appears to be pre-mature.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner will be satisfied, in case, representation Annexure P-6 pertaining to the ineligibility of respondent No.7 for challenging the allotment of shop for running “Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendra” is considered by the Medical Superintendent, Guru Nanak Dev Hospital, Amritsar.

This petition is disposed of, at this stage, being pre-mature with a direction to the President, Bureau of Pharma Public Sector Undertakings of India, respondent No.4 and the Medical Superintendent Guru Nanak Dev

Hospital, respondent No.6 to consider the representation of the petitioner-Association Annexure P-6 within a period of two months after the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order.

It will be the duty of the petitioner-Association to communicate the order to the concerned authorities.

In case, need arises, rules of natural justice will be followed qua respondent No.7.
