JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The owner of the truck has filed the present appeal challenging the order dated 29.08.2014, passed by the Commissioner under Employees Compensation Act, Faridabad. The said truck was being driven by deceased-Dalip Kumar on 22.04.2012 from Faridabad to Hathin, which resulted into his death during the course of employment, resulting into award of compensation for a sum of Rs.8,47,160/- to his family members/claimants (respondents herein).

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the appellant/Employer states that the parties have effected a written compromise deed dated 4/5th December, 2017, whereby the respondents/claimants have been paid a total sum of Rs.2,50,000/- towards full and final settlement of all claims. Therefore, he prays for unconditional withdrawal of the present appeal.

Learned Counsel for the respondents/claimants, on instructions from his client(s), does not refute the aforesaid factual position.

In view of the aforesaid agreed stand, the present appeal is dismissed as withdrawn.
