Ms. Puja Chopra, Advocate has put in appearance and filed her *Vakalatnama* on behalf of legal representatives of respondent No.1, which is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the appellant contends an amicable settlement had taken place between the parties, in compliance of which the appellant had deposited an amount of ₹5,70,000/- towards full and final settlement of the claim of the respondents. The amount has been withdrawn by the respondents and the execution has been dismissed as satisfied by the Executing Court. The statements of the parties recorded before the Executing Court and the order passed by the said Court have been placed on record as Annexures A-2 and A-3 respectively.

Learned counsel for respondent No.1 admits the settlement between the parties and also admits that the claim of the respondent has since been satisfied.

Learned counsel for the appellant contends that in view of the settlement, he does not want to pursue the instant appeal and may be allowed to withdraw the same.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

The statutory amount of ₹25,000/- deposited by the appellant be returned to him.
