The petitioner has challenged a tender process in respect of the allotment of a shop in a hotel run by the respondents.

The petitioner claims that there are various infirmities in the tender process. The petitioner contends that the amount bid by the most competitive bidder of Rs.15 lacs is too high and that the correct amount ought to be at the most Rs.5 to 6 lacs. This is a curious argument. What the petitioner expects this Court to do is to set aside the bid of Rs.15 lacs and to award the contract to a person such as the petitioner who is willing to bid not more than Rs.5 to 6 lacs.

We are not inclined to exercise our extraordinary jurisdiction under Article 226 by passing such an order. The petition is dismissed.
