By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of certiorari/mandamus to quash the impugned letter/communication dated 05.07.2016 (Annexure P-1) whereby claim of petitioner for stepping up of pay equal to his junior has been rejected wrongly and illegally and the same is violative of Articles 14 & 16 of the Constitution. And further to quash ACP Scheme dated 03.11.2006 to the extent that it is implemented w.e.f. 01.11.2006. The petitioner be also given benefit of ACP Scheme as he had completed 6 years service. Further, the respondent be directed to re-fix the pay and pension and other retirement benefits according to the revised pay and to release all the arrears along with interest @ 15% per annum on the basis of revised pay scale

and to grant 4 years ACP w.e.f 01.02.2004 and to refix the pay along with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though various representations including latest representation dated 18.04.2016 (Annexure P-9) were moved to the respondents but till date neither any reply has been received nor any action has been taken.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his latest representation dated 18.04.2016 (Annexure P-9) and decide the same, particularly in view of latest Punjab Civil Services Rules, 2009 applicable w.e.f. 01.01.2006, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case, the petitioner still feels aggrieved against the order passed by respondent(s), he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
