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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The grouse of the petitioner is that her husband Shri Jit Bahadur, who was a Cook in the police mess at Rohtak, was getting pension after his retirement. Jit Bahadur died on 3.2.2008. It is further disclosed that he was first married to one Himmato Devi, out of which a female child, namely, Santosh was born. Thereafter, Jit Bahadur performed second marriage with the present petitioner, from which four children were born. The petitioner is visiting the office of respondents since year 2009. It is stated that now the matter is pending with the office of Accountant General (A and E), Haryana (respondent No. 4 herein), as disclosed in the reply 10.2.2017 (Annexure-P-7). However, no decision regarding the family pension has been taken so far.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the opposite party, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 to take a final decision regarding the family pension case of the

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petitioner, within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in case, an adverse order is sought to be passed, a speaking order in this regard will be passed, giving reasons in support thereof.
