The petitioners have approached this Court seeking following
relief:-

*"Civil Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the
Constitution of India to issue a writ of certiorari or
mandamus or in any other nature thereby directing the
respondent-Municipal Corporation not to construct the
Balmiki Dharamshala in the land of Johar of Village
Mukarabpur;*

OR

to issue any other writ, order or direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the peculiar facts and circumstances of this case."

As per stand of the respondent(s), they will not raise the construction of Balmiki Dharamshala in the land of Johar of Village Mukarabpur.

In view of above, the grievance of the petitioners stands vindicated, therefore, no cause of action survives in the present writ petition.

Since the main writ petition is disposed of, the application bearing CM No.7510 of 2017 seeking impleadment of the applicant, namely, Ashok Kumar as respondent No.5, has been rendered infructuous.
