Learned counsel for the petitioner claims that he is eligible and entitled to the immediate allotment of paddy for custom milling as per the capacity of his rice mill. In this context, he has urged that no doubt there were proceedings pending before the Arbitrator pertaining to certain liabilities of the petitioner which have been decided in favour of the petitioner.

After hearing counsel for the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition in limine.

Notice to Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of Court, Ms. Anu Pal, Asstt. A.G., Punjab accepted the notice. Copy given.

The petition is disposed of with a direction that representations, Annexures P4 and P5, of the petitioner will be considered by the Director, Food and Supplies, Punjab within a period of 15 days after a receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case the petitioner is found entitled and eligible, the allotment of paddy for custom milling may be made subject to the availability of the stocks.
