By this petition the petitioner claims payment at par with his juniors.

In my opinion, it would be appropriate if in the first instance the petitioner moves a self contained representation to the respondent no.2 who would decide the same by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction that in case any such representation is moved within a period of one month from today the same be decided by the respondent No.2 by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of 3 months thereafter. Further if the petitioner is found entitled to any relief claimed the same be granted to him within the aforesaid period.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc.
Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
