In the instant writ petition, the petitioners have sought for directions to relax the age for recruitment to the post of Multipurpose Health Worker (Male) contending that they are already working on *ad hoc* basis. Therefore, for the purpose of participating in the selection process to the post of Multipurpose Health Worker on regular basis age criteria is coming in their way. Hence, they have sought for age relaxation. Admittedly, the petitioners have not submitted any representation or demand to the competent authority to relax the age stipulated in the advertisement. Unless and until there is a demand, this Court cannot issue directions. Therefore, petition stands dismissed reserving liberty to the petitioners to approach the competent authority by making necessary representation/application for relaxation of age for recruitment to the post of

Multipurpose Health Worker (Male) with reference to advertisement vide

Annexure P-1 and P-2. If such representation is submitted, the competent authority is directed to consider the same in accordance with law. While considering so, the competent authority may also take note of Annexure P-15. Such decision shall be taken by the competent authority within a month from the date of receipt of representation.
