17.01.2017 is arising out of service conditions of the petitioner to the extent of remuneration. Therefore, this court has no jurisdiction in view of Section 3(o) and (i) of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007.

Accordingly, CWP stands dismissed for want of jurisdiction of this court. Reserving liberty to approach appropriate forum.
