On the asking of the court, Mr. Avinit Awasthi, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Three copies of the paper book be served upon him during the course of the day.

The land of the petitioners have been acquired for the purpose of establishing a Thermal Plant, a Railway Line and a Canal Minor at Village Aspal, Tehsil and District Mansa. Replying upon the Government Policy dated 08.11.2011 (Annexure P2/T), the contention of the petitioners is that at least their one family member is entitled to be employed in the Government service subject to the academic qualifications possessed by such persons. Their grievance is that the policy decision is not being given effect despite their representations dated 22.12.2011, 08.09.2012 and

11.11.2014 (Annexures P-5/T to P-7/T).

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the nature of the relief sought, I dispose of the writ petition with a direction to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners as contained in their representations 22.12.2011, 08.09.2012 and 11.11.2014 (Annexures P-5/T to P-7/T) in the light of the Government policy dated 08.11.2011 (Annexure P-2/T) and dispose of the same by passing an appropriate order within a period of six months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
