This is a petition under Article 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to release the assured and sanctioned capital subsidy along with interest as per the orders passed in CWP No.19007 of 2002 as per the seniority list prepared by the department.

Learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the Director of Industries and Commerce, Investment Incentives-SSI Wing, Govt. of Punjab, Udyog Bhawan, Sector-17, Chandigarh respondent No.2 to consider the claim of the petitioner submitted vide request Annexure P-4 dated 10.08.2016 as the seniority of the petitioner is at serial No.182 of EOU Units for the disbursement of the abovesaid benefit.

Notice to the State.

Ms. Anu Pal, Asstt. Advocate General, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice.

Counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over two sets of paper book to the State counsel, during course of the day.

Without expression of any opinion regarding the merits of the case and entitlement of the petitioner, this petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the representation of the petitioner Annexure P-4 dated 10.08.2016, by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law, within a period of three months after the receipt of certified copy of this order.

It will be the duty of the petitioner to intimate regarding the directions passed by this Court to respondent No.2.
