This FAO is against the order dated August 08, 2014, of Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Ambala. As agreed, as per the statements of learned counsel for the appellant and the Insurance Company, (seperately recorded), a sum of ₹ 1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lac and Fifty Thousand Only) more, over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. 'Two months' time is allowed to the Insurance Company to deposit the bank draft/ cheque in the name of Ajmer Singh (appellant) in the office of the Lok Adalat of this Court from today, failing which interest at the rate of 9% per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount would be paid

to appellant- Ajmer Singh.

The appeal is disposed of accordingly subject to all just exceptions available in favour of the respondent- Insurance Company.
