The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to allot requisite 5 marks to the petitioner, as per criteria for allotment of marks, for having acquired PDGCA diploma.

Learned counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer that the representation dated 02.10.2016 (Annexure P-5) and legal notice dated 15.01.2017 (Annexure P-6) pending with the respondents-University for grant of higher qualification marks should be decided expeditiously.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and in view of the limited prayer, without going into the merits of the case, I dispose of the instant writ petition by directing the respondents-University to decide the

representation dated 02.10.2016 (Annexure P-5) and legal notice dated 15.01.2017 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioner within a period of three months, in accordance with law, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
