The petitioner herein is claiming promotion to the post of Senior Assistant, being the senior most person in the Scheduled Castes category.

The petitioner has already represented to the respondents- Department vide representation dated 20.10.2014 (Annexure P-5), however, the same is still pending consideration. At the present moment, learned counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer that the representation, as filed, be decided expeditiously.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and in view of the limited prayer, I dispose of the writ petition by directing the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner as expeditiously as possible. The petitioner is directed to file his fresh representation along with certified

copy of this order within three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The respondents herein are directed to dispose of the said representation preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the said representation along with certified copy of the order.

Needless to say, if there is any merit in the claim raised, the necessary relief be granted to the petitioner within a period of two months thereafter.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
