In the present writ petition, petitioners have sought for a writ of mandamus seeking directions to the respondents to consider their eligibility for promotion to the post of PGT (Hindi) as they fulfill the requisite qualification for the promotional post. In the absence of demand before the competent authority straightway they have approached this court. Thus petitioners have not made out a case so as to interfere with the relief sought in the petition.

CWP is dismissed reserving liberty to the petitioners to approach the competent authority by making necessary representation and also pointing out relevant rules and requisite material to demonstrate that they are eligible for promotion to the post of PGT (Hindi). If such representation is made, the competent authority may examine and take a decision at the earliest.

With the above observation petition stands dismissed.
