The petitioner herein applied for the post of Assistant Lineman, pursuant to an advertisement that was issued in the year 2011. The petitioner was shown at Serial No.117 in the general waiting list, however, persons having lower in merit than the petitioner have been considered for appointment.

The petitioner has already represented to the respondents-Corporation by a legal notice dated 18.10.2016 (Annexure P-15), however, the same is pending consideration. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the present moment, limits her prayer that the said legal notice dated 18.10.2016 (Annexure P-15) pending before the respondents-Corporation, should be decided expeditiously, in the light of the judgment rendered in '*Prem Chand and others vs. State of Haryana and others*, Civil Writ Petition

No.17706 of 2013, decided on 18.05.2016.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and in view of the limited prayer, without giving any observation on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition by directing the respondents-Corporation to decide the legal notice dated 18.10.2016 (Annexure P-15) of the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law. Needless to say, in case the petitioner has been found entitled to the claim as sought for, necessary relief be given to him within a period of one month thereafter.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
