KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The civil writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directing the respondents to count the daily wage period in the qualifying service from the period 1977 to 1978 and counting of work charge period in the Department from 1978 to 1984 with interest.

The petitioner worked as a daily wage employee from 1977 to 1978 and as work charge T/Mate employee from 1978 to 1984. He retired from the services in the year 2007. His prayer is that his daily wage service from 1977 to 1978 and work charge period 1978 to 1984 should be counted for the purpose of retiral benefits. He had already issued a legal notice, dated 29.09.2016 (Annexure P1).

The short prayer of the petitioner at this stage is that respondents may be directed to consider the legal notice dated 29.09.2016 (Annexure P-1) and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice dated 29.09.2016 (Annexure P-1) The needful be done within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
