The instant writ petition has been filed seeking step up of pay.

It is contended that the claim of the petitioners would be covered by the judgment rendered in the case of ***“Neelam Rani vs. State of Haryana and others”***, Civil Writ Petition No.11254 of 2010. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in this regard, the petitioners have already approached the department concerned vide advance notice dated 25.11.2016 (Annexure P-13) which is pending consideration.

At the present moment, learned counsel for the petitioners limits has prayer that the said advance notice dated 25.11.2016 (Annexure P-13) be decided expeditiously.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and in view of the limited prayer, without going into the merits of the case, I dispose of the
