It is contended that the petitioner has the requisite qualification and experience to be appointed as Junior Engineer, Electrical, pursuant to an advertisement that was issued in the year 2013 by the Punjab State Transmission Corporation Limited. It is further contended that having secured the necessary marks, appointment is not offered to him. In this regard, the petitioner has already approached the respondents-Corporation for appointment, however, the same is pending consideration. At the present moment, learned counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer that the representation as filed be decided expeditiously.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and in view of the limited prayer, I dispose of the writ petition by directing the respondents-Corporation to decide the representation of the petitioner as expeditiously as possible. The petitioner is directed to file his fresh

representation along with certified copy of this order within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The respondents-Corporation herein is directed to dispose of the said representation preferably within a period of six weeks thereafter, by passing a speaking order, from the date of receipt of the said representation along with certified copy of the order.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
