After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief claimed in this petition the petitioner has also moved a Legal Notice dated 01.12.2016 (Annexure P-6) and at this stage he would be satisfied if the same is decided by the respondent No.5 by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.5 to decide the said legal notice by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. If the petitioner is entitled to any relief the same be granted to him within the aforesaid period. It is made clear that if any due relief is not granted to the petitioner within the aforesaid period he would be entitled to claim the same with interest @ 12% p.a. from the date/s the amount/s fell due till the date/s of payment.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
