The petitioner is resident of Flat No.1072/2, Sector 39-B, Chandigarh which is a multi-storied apartment. He alleges that occupants of apartment of first floor, namely, 1072/1, respondent Nos.7 & 8 have raised unauthorized construction which is not permissible under the Housing Bye-laws. The petitioner further alleges that despite his representation to the authorities, no action is being taken for the removal of unauthorized structure said to have been raised by respondent Nos.7 & 8.

Having heard the petitioner-in-person and considering the nature of relief sought by him, however without expressing any views on merits of the allegations as we have not heard respondent Nos.7 & 8 at this stage, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.2 to 6 to verify the petitioner's allegations and take necessary action in

three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
