The petitioners are oustees whose land was acquired for the development of Rajiv Gandhi Education City near Sonapat. Their grievance is that applications for allotment of oustees plots were invited in the year 2010 and all of them have applied with the requisite amount but no draw of lots is being held though more than six years have passed. The petitioners are running from pillar to post but finding no positive response, the instant writ petition has been filed.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners, it appears *prima-facie* that the HUDA authorities are keeping the earnest money deposited by the petitioners without any justification without holding the draw of lots for such a long period. There can hardly be any legal impediment against draw of lots nor any such like reason has ever been assigned or acknowledged to the petitioners.

In this view of the matter and without expressing any views on merits of the allegations, we dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the Chief Administrator, HUDA, Panchkula and Estate Officer, HUDA,

Sonepat to take up the matter regarding holding of draw of lots for allotment

of plots to oustees and take a final decision within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
