The prayer in this application filed under Section 151 CPC, is for placing on record the amended memo of party.

For the reasons enumerated in the application, the same is allowed and the amended memo of party is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

In view of the above, the present application is disposed of.

CWP No. 6035 of 2017

The petitioner has preferred this writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to release all the pensionary benefits of the petitioner.

Brief facts of this case are that the petitioner claims that she is the first wife of the deceased-Ishwar Singh Nain. Thereafter, the deceased-Ishwar Singh Nain has remarried respondent No. 4 in the year 1993. Now, the petitioner claims the pensionary benefits of her deceased-husband.

CWP No. 6035 of 2017 (O&M)

It is stated that on the representation of the petitioner, an enquiry was marked to the Sub Divisional Officer (Civil) Barwala, who has held that the petitioner is the first wife of the deceased-Ishwar Singh Nain.

It comes out that the petitioner has moved a representation dated 20.09.2016 (*Annexure P-4*) addressed to the respondent No. 2. Now, the short prayer of the petitioner is that respondent No. 2 may be directed to decide the aforesaid representation of the petitioner within a specific time frame.

In the circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents the present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforementioned representation dated 20.09.2016 (*Annexure P-4*) of the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
