In the instant petition, the petitioner has sought for direction to consider his name for appointment on compassionate ground under 1995 Rules/Policy (Annexure P-6) or under 2006 Rules (Annexure P-7).

The petitioner's mother while working as Steno-Typist died on 19.3.1999. The petitioner was minor on that date. His date of birth is 31.1.1998. The petitioner's father submitted an application on 10.8.1999 in which it was claimed that as and when the petitioner attained the age of majority, his name would be considered for appointment on compassionate ground. The petitioner seems to have attained the age of majority in the month of February 2016. Thus, in the month of February 2016, a representation has been submitted for appointing the petitioner on compassionate ground.

The object of granting or extending the benefit of appointment on compassionate ground is to meet the harness in the family. The petitioner survive with his father from 19.3.1999 till date. Therefore, question of any harness in the family in the year 2016-2017 do not arise.

Consequently, the petitioner is not entitled for relief sought in the present

case.

Petition stands dismissed.
