The instant petition has been filed seeking a direction that the representation as filed, which is Annexure P6 on the record, should be decided as expeditiously as possible.

Counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners, who are physically handicapped persons, had applied for the post of Multipurpose Health Workers (Male), pursuant to an advertisement issued. However, in the said advertisement there is no bifurcation of 38 posts reserved for handicap persons, since one per cent each has to be kept reserved in the three categories, as highlighted in letter No.10/26-95-5SW/206 dated 16.01.1997 issued by Government of Punjab. Counsel for the petitioners limits his prayer that the representation as filed be decided as expeditiously as possible.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and in view of

the limited prayer, I dispose of the writ petition by directing respondents to decide the representation of the petitioners as expeditiously as possible. The petitioners are directed to file their fresh representation along with certified copy of this order within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The respondents herein are directed to dispose of the said representation preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the said representation along with certified copy of the order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
