The grievance of the Gram Panchayat in the present writ petition is that despite there being eviction order against the private respondents, the authorities are not taking any steps to take possession of the land and hand over the same to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from Mrs. Saroj Aggarwal, Tehsildar, Kapurthala submitted that there being no stay by any authority against the order of eviction passed against the private respondents, appropriate steps shall be taken to take possession from the unauthorised occupants and hand over the same to the Gram Panchayat. Needful shall be done within a period of four weeks.

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In view of the aforesaid stand taken by learned counsel for the
State, the writ petition is disposed of in terms thereof.
