KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the pending interest on delayed payment @ 9% per annum as compound interest as per Section 13 of the Payment of Gratuity (Central) Rules, 1972-1 in lieu of payment already made by the respondents in view of the legal notice dated 25.11.2016 (Annexure-P3) which has already been served to the respondent.

The short prayer of the petitioners at this stage is that respondents may be directed to consider the legal notice dated 25.11.2016 (Annexure-P3) and pass a speaking order in accordance

with law in a time bound manner.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 25.11.2016 (Annexure-P3). The needful be done within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
