Petitioner is aggrieved by inaction on the part of the officials of Bharat Petroleum Company Limited pertaining to the violation of the guidelines of Indian Road Congress of 2009 and the guidelines for setting up and running up petrol or diesel outlets, committed by respondent No.3. In this respect, a legal notice has been sent by the petitioner to Bharat Petroleum Company Limited.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied in case a direction is issued that legal notice Annexure P-6 is decided by the competent authority of Bharat Petroleum Company Limited.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that the grievance of the petitioner contained in Annexure P-6 will be looked into by respondent No.1 Bharat Petroleum Company Limited and legal notice Annexure P-6 dated 17.10.2015 will be considered by passing a speaking order by the Managing Director of the said Company within a period of

three months after the receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the circumstances warranted any action sequel to the consideration of the notice, the same may be taken.

It will be the duty of the petitioner to intimate the order to respondent No.1.
